Free Public Forum on Climate Change

Hendersonville, N.C.

On October 27, 2019, from 2-4 p.m., Citizens Concerned with the Climate Crisis, a local, volunteer, grass-roots initiative, will convene "From Climate Talk to Citizen Action," a free, interactive forum open to the public.

Panel members, including an expert from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, will provide the most recent information on the extent of the climate problem in Western North Carolina and its impact, and advance recommendations for how businesses and individuals can become part of solutions.

The forum will be held at Grace Lutheran Church, Stull Hall, Sixth Avenue and Blythe Street, in Hendersonville.
